Henry E. Williams, Jr., age 86, of Trooper, PA, passed away on Saturday, June 18, 2016 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born on April 17, 1930 in Norristown, PA, he was a son of the late Henry E. Sr. and Anna (Dietz) Williams.

Mr. Williams worked as a printer for the Allenwood Steel Company, AEL, and then Sorbus before retiring in 1984.
