



## Mrs. Irina E. Osinski

June 13, 1936 - May 13, 2016

Irina E. Osinski, age 79, wife of Julian L. Osinski, of Valley Forge, PA, died Friday, May 13, 2016 in Seasons Hospice at Phoenixville Hospital. Born on June 13, 1936 in Frankfurt, Germany, she was the youngest twin daughter of Eugene and Else (Hartmann) Ryshkewitch. She immigrated to the United States with her family in 1948, and settled in Dayton, OH, where she met Julian Osinski at Fairview High School and married him a few years after her graduation. Mrs. Osinski owned and ran a home-based sales business for over 40 years, and loved talking to and getting to know her loyal customers as she worked with them over the decades.
