March 5, 1925 - July 24, 2020

Irma Mastrangelo, age 95, wife of the late Ralph Mastrangelo, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Friday, July 24, 2020 in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on March 5, 1925 in Stowe, PA, she was a daughter of the late Michael and Esther (Takach) Bodnar.

Mrs. Mastrangelo attended West Pottsgrove schools, where she loved sports and excelled in field hockey. She was an active, faithful, and life member of the Parkside United Church of Christ in Phoenixville. Mrs. Mastrangelo was employed by the Dana Corporation in Pottstown for 10 years during World War II, and would then go on to work at Parsons and Baker Knitting Mill in Phoenixville until the early 1960s. It was then that she took on the role of a homemaker, tending to her family and the business, Mastrangelo's Produce.

Mrs. Mastrangelo was a member of the 12th Armored Division Association, the Phoenixville Senior Center, and a former member of TOPS in Pottstown. She loved to bake, was an avid gardener, and enjoyed crocheting.

Mrs. Mastrangelo is survived by three sons, Ralph, husband of Patricia Mastrangelo of Elverson, PA, William P., husband of Trish Mastrangelo of Spring City, PA and their children Kyle and Justin, and Paul M., husband of Carolyn Mastrangelo of Pottstown, PA and their daughter Jennifer, wife of Timothy Crane. She was preceded in death by one daughter, Kathleen

Mastrangelo; one grandson, Matthew Mastrangelo; three siblings, Margaret Thees, Esther Tavalese, and Paul Koachmor; and one niece Vilma Brumbach.
