James G. Callahan IV, age 53, of Upper Providence Township, passed away on Saturday, March 20, 2021 in the Bryn Mawr Hospital. Born on August 31, 1967 in Westwood, NJ, he was a son of the late James and Sandra (West) Callahan, and was raised by his maternal grandparents Ruth and Denver West.

Jim was a graduate of Pearl River High School in Pearl River, NY, as well as the University of Albany, SUNY. He was the Vice President of Enterprise Risk and Resilience at AmerisourceBergen, and was part of their Covid-19 global task force. Jim was the Cubmaster for Cub Scout Pack 27 with his boys, and loved animals and to travel.

Jim enjoyed photography, a passion that led him to the Black Rock Fire Company in 2004 as the department photographer. Shortly thereafter, he continued on with firefighting training, and served as the Assistant Chief of the Oaks Fire Company. Currently, Jim was the Deputy Chief of the Black Rock Fire Company, as well as the President of the Fire Company as well as the President of the Relief Association. He was also a member of the Montgomery County Fire Chiefs Association.

Jim is survived by three sons, Casey J. Callahan, Connor W. Callahan, Dylan J. Callahan and their mother, Marcie Callahan of Collegeville, PA; two half-

brothers, Danny Callahan and Michael Callahan of New York; and several Aunts, Uncles, and cousins.

Relatives and friends are invited to attend his viewing from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM, followed by a funeral ceremony at 4:30 PM at Christ's Church of the Valley, 1560 Yeager Road, Royersford, PA 19468 on Saturday, March 27, 2021.
