James G. Greco, age 66, of Phoenixville, PA, died suddenly of natural causes while hunting in Sullivan County on Tuesday, October 18, 2011. Born in Norristown, he was a son of the late James J. and Rose (Carneavale) Greco. Mr. Greco was a graduate of the Norristown High School. He retired last year after working for over 48 years at Aramark in Philadelphia. He was a member of the St. Ann's Roman Catholic Church in Phoenixville. Mr. Greco was also a member of the Ferko String Band in Phila., the Norristown Bocce Club, The Norristown Maenner-Chor Club, The Hemlock Haven Hunting Club in Sullivan County, and a life member of the Montgomery Hose and Fire Company in Norristown. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and making his own home made wine. Mr. Greco is survived by three children; Lisa M.
