James Patrick Lynch (Jake), age 30, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Sunday, August 20, 2023. Born on September 2, 1992 in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was a son of Kevin and Elizabeth Lynch.

Jake graduated from Phoenixville High School, where he excelled as a student and athlete on the basketball and tennis teams. He furthered his education at Duquesne University, where his focus was on business and psychology. Ever since first grade, Jake dreamed of being a salesman like his father. His journey in sales began with the best selling lemonade in Ocean City, NJ. Jake had his entire family, including Grammy, working in the kitchen to keep up with the public's demand!
