James A. Moran III, age 72, husband of Kathleen M. (Dugan) Moran, of Royersford, PA, passed away on Monday, February 2, 2015 at home. Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of the late James A. Jr. and Ava Marie (Reardon) Moran.

Mr. Moran was a 1959 graduate of St. Joseph Preparatory High School, a 1963 graduate of St. Joseph University, and received his MBA from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania in 1967.
