James V. Nash, Sr., age 83, husband of Elizabeth A. (Marinari) Nash, of Limerick, PA, died peacefully on Friday, July 28, 2017 surrounded by his loving family. Born on February 17, 1934 in Bridgeport, PA, he was a son of the late John T. and Anna (Dever) Nash. He was a 1952 graduate of the West Philadelphia Catholic High School.
