James M. Weiser, 70, husband of Eleanor (Mazurek) Weiser, of Upper Providence, passed away on Tuesday, August 26, 2008, in the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of the late John J. and Adalaide (Cramp) Weiser.
