Janette H. Pfaff, age 79, wife of the late Raymond L. Pfaff, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Saturday, January 5, 2019 in her home. Born on April 21, 1939 in Glasgow, Scotland, she was a daughter of the late George and Jessie (Hamilton) Younger.

After moving to America, Mrs. Pfaff worked as a nurse for some of the Philadelphia Eagles in her early years. A hard worker all her life, in her retirement, she dedicated her time and devotion caring for hundreds of babies in the nursery at the Phoenixville YMCA. A fixture of the Phoenixville community, she was an active supporter of the local DFW and a staple of the Phoenixville Public Library, reading four books per week for the past 30 years.
