Janice L. "Jackie" (Svetich) Poteete Moody, age 83, wife of David G. Moody, of Royersford, Pennsylvania, passed away on Sunday, June 28, 2020 in Kadima Rehabilitation and Nursing at Pottstown, South Coventry. Born on October 29, 1936 in Lewistown, Montana, she was a daughter of the late Melba (Mabis) and Peter Svetich.

Shortly after graduating high school in Montana, Janice and her sister spent a few years in Erie, PA, until she ended up setting down in Royersford. She was active at the gym, enjoyed crossword puzzles and gardening and was an avid reader. Most importantly, she was a compassionate caregiver for anyone that needed help.
