Jayme Lee Adams, age 51, husband of Teresita (Camacho-Madrigal) Adams, of Pottstown, PA, passed away on Monday, October 19, 2020 in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on February 13, 1969 in Carlisle, PA, he was a son of the late Kenneth Adams and Beulah (Dick) Bender.

Jayme was a graduate of Carlisle High School, and would go on to serve in the United States Army for 11 years. He served during the Gulf War, supporting the United Nations as well as several other humanitarian organizations. He received his associates degree while in the military, and his most proud moments came when his sons both joined the Army. Following his time in the military, he would go on to work as a Union carpenter for Local 256 while in Georgia, and most recently for Local 465 in Philadelphia.

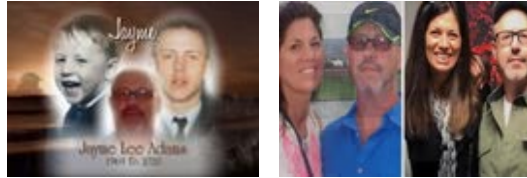
