Jeffrey Gordon Little, age 64, Husband of Maureen Kennedy of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Wednesday, August 14, 2024 in the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, PA. Born in Bethlehem, he was the Son of Joanne (Hunter) and Gordon Little.

Jeff was a 1978 graduate of Valley Forge Military Academy and attended Bloomsburg University. He worked in HVAC sales most recently with Emcor Services.
