Joan M. "Jonni" (Hartmann) Bamberger, age 84, wife of the late Hugh B. "Pete" Bamberger, of Wyomissing, PA, formerly Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Thursday, August 4, 2016 in Columbia Cottage Wyomissing. Born on April 1, 1932 in Philadelphia, PA, she was a daughter of the late Francis and Mathilde (Voss) Hartmann.

Mrs. Bamberger was a member of St. Basil the Great Roman Catholic Church in Kimberton. She was a graduate of Mount St. Joseph Academy and the Chestnut Hill College.
