Joan Marie (Parr) Solick, age 82, wife of the late Michael S. Solick, of Spring City, PA, passed away on Tuesday, March 23, 2021 in the Spring Mill Senior Living community, Phoenixville. Born on March 10, 1939 in Hanover, PA, she was a daughter of the late Burnell W. and Ethel M. (Carbaugh) Parr.

Mrs. Solick was a graduate of Shippensburg High School and received her Bachelor's degree in music education from the West Chester State Teachers College. She was a faithful member of St. Joseph Roman Catholic Church in Spring City, where she was a member of the Josephine Servites of Mary. Mrs. Solick taught private voice and piano lessons, sang for several local churches, and delighted the community and beyond through her singing engagements.

A dedicated wife, mother, and grandmother, she celebrated Christmas year-round, was a phenomenal cook, and loved visiting with her grandchildren and her friends. She was a talented crafter, painting ceramics, knitting, and

arranging flowers. Mrs. Solick enjoyed golfing with her husband and close friends, and was a member of the Meadowbrook and Spring Hollow golf course ladies' leagues. She was an active member of the local Red Hat Society.

Mrs. Solick was preceded in death by two brothers, Robert Parr and William Parr.
