John Patrick Duff, age 46, husband of Vicki Ann (Pierce) Duff, lifelong resident of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Monday, November 14, 2022 in the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia. Born in Phoenixville, he was a son of Thomas Duff, of Audubon and the late Barbara (Breen) Duff.

A 1994 graduate of Phoenixville High School, John received an associates degree from The University of Johnson and Wales Culinary Arts School in Providence, RI. 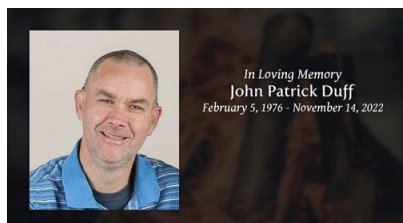
