John was born to John Leo O'Brien and Helen (Lawrence) O'Brien, in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania. After his service to the Air Force, John joined the General Electric corporate audit staff and went on to various financial management positions in various locations (New York, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Florida), over a 35-year career.
