Joseph C. Ball, age 74, husband of Kathryn M. (Ruth) Ball, of Phoenixville, PA passed away on Saturday, May 23, 2015 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of the late Raymond and Anna (Huston) Ball.

Mr. Ball retired from the United States Marine Corps, where he served several tours in Vietnam and rose in rank to Gunnery Sergeant.
