Joseph R. Chico, age 78, husband of Lila Jayne (March) Chico, of Chester Springs, PA died late Wednesday evening, June 22, 2011 in the Chester County Hospital, West Chester, PA from complications following abdominal surgery last week. Born on the Chico family farm in Phoenixville, he was a son of the late Anthony A. Chico, Sr., and Victoria A. (Plish) Chico. He worked on the family farm for many years. Mr. Chico was a former Borough council member in Phoenixville. An electrical contractor, Mr. Chico owned and operated the Chico Electric and Appliance Store in Phoenixville. He was honored with a life membership of the PA State Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 66. He was a very active member there for many years. In addition to his wife, Mr. Chico is survived by two children; Monique V. Chico, of Phoenixville, Joseph R. Chico, Jr., of Chester Springs, PA, two sisters; Irene M.
