



## Joseph Hozyash

May 2, 1918 - August 19, 2015

Joseph Hozyash, age 97, husband of the late Alberta T. (DiGuissepe) Hozyash, of Royersford, PA died Wednesday, August 19, 2015. Born on May 2, 1918 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late John and Christine (Sodaski) Hozyash. He attended East Coventry School. A veteran, he served for the U.S. Army's 339th Polar Bear Regt, 85th Custer Division, 5th Army during the Africa and Italy Campaign during World War II. Mr. Hozyash worked at Bethlehem Steel Grace Mines from 1954-1978. He then worked for the Montgomery County Geriatric and Rehabilitation Center from 1979-1984.
