Joseph A. Keim, 91, husband of Dorothy M. (Brouse) Keim, of Royersford, formerly Linfield, passed away on Thursday morning, June 4, 2015, in the Parkhouse Providence Pointe. Born in Mahanoy City, he was a son of the late Vincent and Agnes (Burns) Keim.

Mr. Keim served in the United States Army Air Corps during World War II. He had been employed at Diamond Glass in Royersford for 29 years until his 1986 retirement. He was a member of Sacred Heart Church and a life member of Linfield Fire Co., where he had also been a former volunteer firefighter.

An outdoorsman, Joseph loved to hunt, fish and listen to country music. He was an avid gardener which could be seen by the beautiful flowers around his home. He loved the Phillies and had a love hate relationship with the Eagles. Mr. Keim also loved to travel, having visited 49 out of 50 states.
