Joseph O. McCann (Joe), age 83, husband of Carole A. (MacMullen) McCann, of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Friday, December 10, 2021 in his residence. Born on January 17, 1938 in Phoenixville, he was the son of the late Jeannette (Raser) and Francis P. McCann.

After graduating from Norristown High School, Joe served honorably in the United States Navy.
