Joseph J. Neizer, age 87, husband of Florence E. (Fischer) Neizer, of Phoenixville, passed away on Thursday, April 23, 2015 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born in Phoenixville and a life-long resident, he was a son of the late Jacob and Rose (Rossman) Neizer.

Joe was a 1945 graduate of Phoenixville High School, where during World War II, he was in charge of the High School's scrap metal drive. The day after he graduated, he enlisted in the United States Navy. He was the honor man of his boot camp company and proceeded to serve in the Pacific Theater. Upon returning home, Joe operated The Lodge Restaurant in Schuylkill Township for a time before opening an Esso Station where he served the Phoenixville community for many years. He finished his career as a self-employed mechanic. He held a life membership at West End Fire Company in Phoenixville, and was an avid hunter, fisher, and sports fan, most notably of the Phillies, Eagles, and Phoenixville High School football.

In addition to his wife of 62 years, Joe is survived by two children, Joyce, wife of Tom Gradel of Pottstown, PA and Joseph, husband of Victoria Bardsley of Danville, PA; four grandchildren, Kimberly, wife of Skip Lessig, Christopher, husband of Frances Gradel, Kelli, wife of Dave Hoffman, and Brittany Gradel; one great grandson, Jeremy Lessig; and numerous nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by five brothers and two sisters. Joe was deeply loved by

his family and friends who will miss his cheerful smile, colorful stories and sweet demeanor.
