In 1962, Mr. Puleo obtained his Real Estate License, and was partner / owner of J. Puleo & Sons Real Estate.? In 1967 he obtained his Real Estate Brokers License.? He was partner / owner of the J. Puleo & Sons Real Estate for over 44 years.? In 1989 he was selected as the Outstanding Realtor of the Year by the Chester County Association of Realtors.?

Mr. Puleo was very active member of the Phoenixville Community.?
