



## Joyce E. Ehnot

Joyce E. Ehnot, 80, of Bradenton, FL and formerly of Pottstown and Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at the Reading Hospital. She was the wife of the late Elmer E. Ehnot, who died January 5, 1980.
