Judith E. Di Sandri, age 85, wife of the late Antal G. Di Sandri, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away suddenly on Sunday, March 6, 2016 in the Paoli Hospital, Paoli PA. Born on December 14, 1930 in Bekescsaba, Hungary, she was the daughter of the late Mihaly and Maria (Tyirjak) Zsiros. She was an exceptionally gifted student. She met, fell in love and married her late husband Antal in February 1952 and remained happily married for 58 years until his passing in 2010.
