Judith L. Whitman, wife of Kenneth G. Whitman, of Rehoboth Beach, DE and formerly of Trappe, PA, died Saturday, June 9, 2018 at her home. She was 75.

Born on May 19, 1943 in Phoenixville, PA, she was the daughter of the late Ralph W. Sr. and Julia (Pete) Hilborn. Judi graduated from Spring-Ford High School in 1961. She was a homemaker and was employed as a medical secretary.
