After working for 33 years, the doctors told her she should stop driving and employment. At that time, Judy started volunteering at the Phoenixville Hospital at the front desk. She volunteered for 8 years. Judy also loved to sew, making scrubs for the nurses. She was an animal lover, especially the Boston Terriers.
