Katherine E. Glowacki, age 61, wife of Mark A. Glowacki, of Spring City, PA, passed away on Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at home. Born on May 19, 1959 in Philadelphia, PA, she was a daughter of the late William and Louise (Kehan) Davis.

Katie grew up in the Lawncrest section of Philadelphia and attended St. Williams grade school where she met her husband Mark in the second grade. She often spoke fondly of childhood memories with her siblings and parents spending time at Neshaminy creek. She graduated from Cardinal Dougherty High School, where she played basketball. After high school Katie and Mark were married and began to raise their 5 children. She was like a "second mom" to many nieces, nephews, and friend's children. Her kitchen table was always filled with guests and laughter. Katie cherished and loved the time she got to be around her family. To her, the larger the gathering was, the better. She was a proud breast and lung cancer survivor. Dogs were a constant through her life, she loved them, and she loved dog sitting for her children any

chance she could. She enjoyed family trips to Wildwood and spending time on the boat water skiing and tubing. Her most cherished role became her time known as "Queenie," the nickname she gave herself instead of Grandmom. She was so proud of her 7 grandsons and most recently her new granddaughter.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Glowacki is survived by five children, Christopher T., husband of Emily Glowacki, Katherine K. Glowacki, Nicholas T., husband of Nadine Glowacki, Tara D. Glowacki, and Matthew T. Glowacki; eight grandchildren, Nicholas and Nathan Glowacki, Aiden Glowacki, Mark, Elliot and Nova Glowacki, Rylo and Amir Smith; six siblings, Patricia, wife of the late Gerald Healey, Carol Miller, Joseph, husband of Roxanne Davis, Diane, wife of Val Pavlov, Charles, husband of Kathy Davis, and Thomas Davis; her sister-in-law, Joanne Davis; and several nieces and nephews. 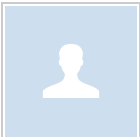
