Kathleen S. Brown, of Upper Providence Township, formerly of Worcester, PA and Somers Point, NJ, died Monday morning, March 30, 2015 in the Phoenixville Hospital, Phoenixville, PA. Born on April 13, 1934 in Brownsville, PA, she was a daughter of the late David and Nellie (Collins) Brown. She was a 1952 graduate of the Bethel High School in Bethel Borough, Pennsylvania.
