Kathleen A. (Kelly) Fullam, age 66, wife of Michael P. Fullam, of Royersford, PA, passed away on Friday, May 3, 2019 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born on April 3, 1953 in Bryn Mawr, PA, she was a daughter of the late Robert and Agnes (Conwell) Kelly.

Mrs. Fullam was a graduate of Phoenixville High School. She completed her undergraduate work from West Chester University, and obtained her Masters Degree from the University of Pennsylvania. She practiced family therapy in her own private practice as well as a local group practice. Mrs. Fullam was dedicated to her husband, her children and their spouses and her six grandchildren. She loved each moment she spent with her grandchildren, following them in their activities as their biggest supporter. She loved to travel, and truly enjoyed being at the Jersey shore in Ocean City, NJ with family and friends, sitting in a circle on the beach and sharing stories, joy and laughter. She was an avid reader and enjoyed dancing. Mrs. Fullam was a dedicated animal lover, and her busy home always included several pets of different types. Above all, Mrs. Fullam loved her Lord Jesus as a member of St. Ann's Parish. She spent significant time praying for family and friends, read scripture daily, and joyfully shared her faith with everyone she knew. She dedicated her life to helping others through her work as a family therapist. Christmas was by far her favorite holiday, when she set the record of housing 9 full-size Christmas trees in her home.
