



## Kenneth Larry Wadsworth

Kenneth Larry Wadsworth, age 84, husband of Barbara J. (Borden) Wadsworth, of Royersford, PA, died Thursday, April 6, 2017 in his home surrounded by his family. Kenny was an EMT and driver for Friendship Ambulance for 40 years. He served as a member of Royersford Borough Council for over 20 years.
