Kevin Christopher DenDulk, age 30, of Limerick, PA, passed away on Saturday, August 1, 2020. Born on February 24, 1990 in Pompton Plains, NJ, he was a son of Arie and Cheryl (O'Dell) DenDulk of Limerick, PA.

Kevin graduated from the PA Cyber Charter School, received his Associate's degree from Delaware County Community College, and attended Liberty University. Throughout his youth, he was active in the Christ Community Church youth ministry in West Chester. Kevin also participated in a missionary trip through Liberty University to Thailand.

Kevin worked making highways safer for Guidemark, Inc. of Souderton, a job he had for a total of 10 years. Kevin also worked as a Corrections Officer for two years at the Chester County Prison.

Kevin trained in the art of Jiu-Jitsu at Precision Jiu-Jitsu. He kept in contact

with friends from the Liberty University martial arts club and recently interacted with them remotely. He loved to read, and greatly enjoyed science fiction and Star Wars. A fan of Warhammer 40,000, Kevin accumulated many figurines that he meticulously painted.

Most important to Kevin was his family. Always excited for family gatherings, he loved spending time with them all. He always looked forward to family vacations, including taking several cruises. He also cherished Wolfie, his Yorkie-Pomeranian dog.

In addition to his parents, Kevin is survived by one brother, Lieutenant Commander Aaron D. DenDulk, USCG, and his wife Krista, his nephew and niece Levi and Leisel of Haymarket, VA; his maternal grandmother, Charlotte, wife of the late Verbal O'Dell of Clearwater, FL; his paternal grandfather, Leenderd, husband of the late Harmanna denDulk of Toms River, NJ; and many Aunts, Uncles, and cousins.

Relatives and friends are invited to attend his funeral ceremony at the Christ Community Church, 1190 Phoenixville Pike, West Chester, PA 19380 on Sunday, August 9, 2020 at 2:30 PM. The service will take place outdoors, undercover, so those attending are requested to wear comfortable, business casual attire. There will be no visitation prior to the service. Masks will be required until you are seated, and social distancing will be required. 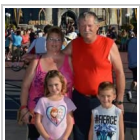

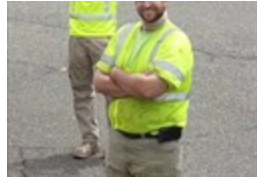
