Lawrence E. Edwards, Jr., age 88, husband of Gladys M. (Stinson) Edwards, of Newmanstown, PA formerly of Elverson, PA died Tuesday evening, August 17, 2010 in the Reading Hospital, Reading, PA after a lengthy illness. Born in Jonesboro Tennessee, he was a son of the late Lawrence E. Edwards, Sr. and Bonnie (Bashore) Edwards. A veteran, he served for the U.S. Army during World War II. Mr. Edwards was self employed most of his life. He worked as a farmer, grew mushrooms and was a heavy equipment operator. In addition to his wife of 67 years, Mr. Edwards is survived by five children; Lawrence E. Edwards, III, husband of Susan Edwards, of Mechanicsburg, PA, M.
