



## Lawrence Evans

September 20, 1950 - October 23, 2009

Lawrence S. Evans, age 59, of Phoenixville, PA died Friday afternoon, October 23, 2009 in the Phoenixville Hospital, Phoenixville, PA of complications from pneumonia. Born in Delaware County, he was a son of the late John P. and Anne (Shields) Evans. He spent much of his life in Glen Mills and Downingtown and ultimately settled in the Kimberton area in 1987. Mr. Evans worked for many years as a customer service attendant for the Kimberton Genuardi's, and as boxmaker at Rocco's Pizza in Kimberton and The Franco Ristorante in Phoenixville.
