Leona P. (Royer) List, age 94, of Royersford, PA died Saturday morning, April 13, 2013 in the Seasons Hospice at Phoenixville Hospital. Born in Limerick, PA, on August 14, 1918, she was a daughter of the late David and Emma (Geisinger) Royer. She was a 1936 graduate of the Royersford High School.
