



## Lewis Peck

August 20, 1924 - May 12, 2012

Lewis S. Peck, age 87, husband of E. Arline (Geiger) Peck, of Parker Ford, PA passed away on Saturday, May 12, 2012 in the Pottstown Memorial Medical Center. Born in Lionville Station, PA, he was a son of the late Granville H. and Mary A. (Walley) Peck. Mr. Peck served in the U.S. Army Air Forces during World War II. He was a paratrooper with the 101st, 82nd, and 17th airborne divisions. He attended Parker Ford Baptist Church. Mr. Peck worked as a sheet metal mechanic for Williard Sheet Metal Co. in Philadelphia and Jenkintown, and was a member of the Sheet Metal Workers Local Union #19.
