Lloyd O. Watts, age 83, husband of Florence (Zawitkowski) Watts, lifetime resident of Spring City, Pennsylvania, passed away on Friday, February 10, 2023 in his residence. Born on January 20, 1940, in Phoenixville. He was the son of the late Verda (Ott) and Lloyd K. Watts.

Lloyd was a class of 1957 graduate of Spring-Ford High School and served honorably in the United States Navy as an Aviation Electrician's Mate until his honorable discharge. He had been employed as a truck driver for Jones Motor Trucking Co. in Spring City prior to becoming a self employed electrician.

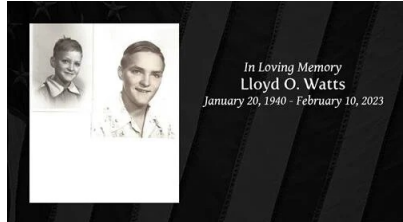
