



## Louis A. Viola, Sr.

July 8, 1938 - September 17, 2022

Louis A. Viola, Sr., age 84, husband of the late Faye L. (Sheeler) Viola, of Royersford, Pennsylvania, passed away on Saturday, September 17, 2022 in Lehigh Valley Hospital - Cedar Crest. Born on July 8, 1938 in Phoenixville, he was one of nine children born to the late Elizabeth (Cutillo) and Albert Viola.

Lou honorably served in the United States Army, stationed in Germany. He had been employed for 35 years, enjoying his job, at Dana Corporation in Pottstown, until his early retirement at the age of 59.

Lou loved shooting pool and played at the level of a professional. He was an avid reader of the daily paper and enjoyed working on the crossword puzzles. He also loved trips to the casinos with his brothers and sisters, riding around his yard on his lawn mower, watching football and going to watch high school state and college wrestling matches. 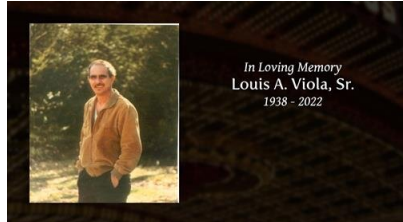
