Luiza Alves DaSilva was born on January 23, 1942, in Maranhão, Brazil. She was the daughter of Isabel, who lived to the age of 96, and Otacilio, who lived into his 80s. 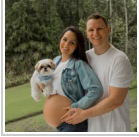

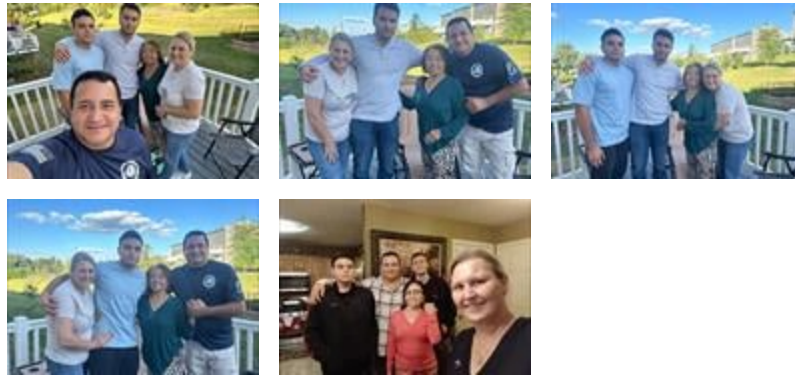
