Marion Leanna (Funk) Graham, 92, of the Masonic Village at Lafayette Hill, passed away on Wednesday, May 22, 2013. She was the widow of Harry E. "Bobo" Graham, to whom she shared fifty years of marriage. She was born on East Seven Stars Road to the late Clarence and Georgia (Gerhardt) Funk and was raised in Kimberton. She was a 1938 graduate of Phoenixville High School and played cornet in the first dancing band directed by Walter Sample. She was a graduate of the Marinella School of Beauty Culture in 1939 and worked the next twenty-one years as a hairdresser in Pottstown. Her career also included time as a secretary to the director of safety at Phoenix Steel Company and also in the quality control lab at the West Company for seventeen years before retiring. She was a member of East Vincent United Church of Christ, where she served as President of the Rosetta Class. She was also active in masonic auxiliaries. Marion was a Past Matron of the former Manavon Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star and current member of Eastern Star's Spring-Ford Chapter. She was also a Past District Deputy Grand Matron and a Past President of the former Auxiliary of the Jerusalem Commandery of Phoenixville. She is survived by her sons: Ronald M., husband to Lyn Graham, of Phoenixville; H.
