



## Mark Hagner,

October 21, 1917 - January 22, 2011

Mark R. Hagner, Sr., age 93, husband of Elizabeth M. (MacFarland) Hagner, of Parkesburg, PA, formerly of King of Prussia, passed away Saturday evening, January 22, 2011 at home surrounded by his family. Born in Norristown, he was a son of the late Henry and Sarah (Steifel) Hagner. Mr. Hagner was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Oaks, PA, and attended Norristown High School. He then went on to serve in the United States Army during World War II. A true "jack of all trades", he worked for and retired from the Johnson & Johnson Company in King of Prussia and Bridgeport. Mr. Hagner was a member of the Valley Forge VFW Post #7878. He enjoyed to garden, cook, camp, fish, and go boating. The most important aspect of life was raising his eleven children and teaching them different skills. Mr. Hagner was also proud to have lived in his home in King of Prussia for over 49 years.
