



## Mark Isanski

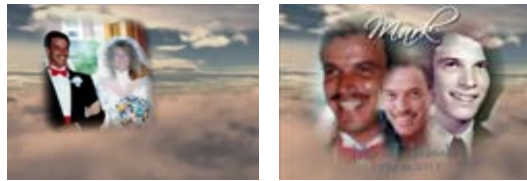
January 23, 1958 - June 28, 2013
