Mark B. Wagner, age 53, husband of Jacqueline P. (Cieplinski), of Royersford, PA passed away on Saturday, June 30, 2012 in the Seasons Hospice at Phoenixville Hospital following his courageous three and a half year battle with brain cancer. Born in Reading, PA, he was a son of Erma K. (Fultz) Wagner and the late Dallas E. Wagner. Mr. Wagner was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wernersville, PA. He worked in aerospace engineering for Lockheed Martin for many years before working for The SI Organization.
