Mary Ann "Molly" (Caffrey) Szegedy, 78, of Phoenixville PA passed away peacefully on January 9, 2016. Molly was a lifelong resident of Phoenixville.

She was employed by Bell Telephone and Charles Lachman Industries. She then took time off to raise her two children, Bob Szegedy of Phoenixville and Jean Szegedy, also of Phoenixville. Molly returned to work first at Wyeth Pharmaceuticals, then wound up her working years as Miss Molly at the Phoenixville YMCA Child Care Facility.

She was also deeply involved with the Phoenixville Community. Molly served on the Phoenixville Area School District School Board for 13 years, was an active member of the Republican Party, a charter member of the Phoenixville Area Historical Society, a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and an involved member of St. Ann's Church.

Molly is survived by her husband of 56 years, Edward Szegedy, her children Bob and Jean Szegedy and four grandchildren, Drew, Maxwell and Mason Kulp and Kelsey Szegedy. She is also survived by two brothers, Eugene Caffrey and Donald Caffrey.
