Matthew J. Kuliszewski, Jr. 80, of Royersford, formerly Wenonah, NJ, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family, on Wednesday, June 7, 2017. He was born on March 15, 1937 in Philadelphia. Upon graduation from Northeast Public High School, Matthew received a full scholarship to West Pointe Military Academy. He had a successful career in sales and was a regional sales manager for Air King Corp.

Matthew had a passion for music and singing, performing in many shows and had his own band, (High Hopes.) He was an excellent vocalist and instrumentalist, playing the saxophone and bass guitar, and also performing many years in the Mummers Parade. An actor and performer, he had roles in many major movies, commercials and community theater. He was an avid reader, enjoying history, autobiographies of U.S. Presidents, Stephen King novels and sports genres. He was a huge Philadelphia sports fan and a Marlton, NJ recreational little league football coach. He loved animals and enjoyed gardening.

He had a strong will and positive attitude. He was the life of the party with a great sense of humor. His famous quote was, "Never had a bad day in my life."

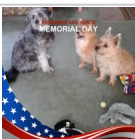
