Matthew is also survived by Veronica's family including her father, Francisco Rojo, husband of the late Maria Rojo, 7 siblings and 13 nieces and nephews.

He will be forever missed. His dream of creating a safe and holy place to celebrate life will be his legacy. In his short 49 years, Matthew was a cherished son and brother, a loving and generous husband and father. He worked his entire career in healthcare and most recently as a Pharmaceutical Executive. His entire family will always remember his abiding love of God, family, and friends. He was also Executive Producer of the musical, "The Answer", a play for the ages about life's struggles and God's compassion.

Matthew was a 1987 graduate of Arch Bishop John Carroll High School in Radnor, PA. He attended Temple University from 1990-1994, where he received his Bachelor of Science (BS) in Chemistry. From 2007-2010, he earned his Master of Science (MS) in Biotechnology, and from 2011-2014 he received his Master of Business Administration (MBA), also in Biotechnology,

both from the University of Maryland, University College. He enjoyed a dynamic career in the Pharmaceutical industry in California before relocating to Bellevue, Idaho to pursue his dream of owning an organic farm. In the short time he's been in Idaho, he has transformed the Morningstar Farm into an organic and free-range chicken and turkey and sustainable fish environment.

“ We were introduced to Matt when he was looking to develop a Christian musical-play. Jim had completed the music and storyline for a musical-play without financing to proceed. I had to yet write the script. A mutual friend connected us after meeting Matt at a conference in Charlotte, NC. To us it was an absolute miracle!

As remarkable as it was to proceed with the play, now entitled *THE ANSWER*, we quickly learned this man was as remarkable as the miracle that brought us together. He was generous, intelligent with an unbelievable memory, and resourceful at finding solutions to the obstacles that came our way. All of these amazing characteristics were presented within his humble, gentle demeanor. He became the Executive Producer of *THE ANSWER* that went far beyond his financial support. He also became a close, dear friend.

He flew or drove from Idaho to Evansville, IN to participate in all the important events for the play. The cast began to look forward to his visits. He, Veronica and Matthew came to Evansville for 2 weeks to be present for the final rehearsals and the run of the play. Matt visited homeless shelters, food kitchens and stood in the 90+ degree heat to give away tickets he had purchased for the play; testimonies of those having encounters with Christ at the performances followed in the days, weeks and months that followed the play.

Matt was passionate about this original musical play. He said *THE ANSWER* was his most important project. He even taught himself to be a videographer to edit the video footage which can be seen on this website. (see 14 min video on theanswertoday.com)

Matt was dedicated to the Lord completely and supremely. I can only describe His relationship with Christ by creating a word picture from the Old Testament priests. As they were anointed with oil, it was poured on the top of their heads, it ran down their beards, and flowed past the hem of their garments. The essence of the oil permeated their every move; the fragrance lingered after they

passed by. Matt's every movement, his every decision, his very life had this essence—this fragrance. He was a true disciple of Christ.

Matt was a man of prayer who discerned the voice and leading of God as is described in John 10:27-28:

“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish...”

Matt will be missed profoundly, but we take comfort knowing he was appointed by God, he now has gained eternal life and his fruit will remain as promised.

should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit shall remain...”

Matt has left much fruit on earth which, indeed, shall remain.
