October 27, 1959 - November 1, 2008

Michael Patrick Kurtas, age 49, of Stowe, PA, died in the Lehigh Valley Trauma Center on Saturday morning, November 1, 2008 from injuries sustained in a fall at his home on Thursday. Born in Pottstown, he was a son of Josephine A. (Cassidy) Kurtas, of Linfield, PA, and the late James G. Kurtas. He was a 1979 graduate of the Spring-Ford High School. Mr. Kurtas owned and operated the Sunshine Pool Company in Stowe for a number of years. He attended the Blessed Teresa of Calcutta R.C. Church that was formerly St. Clare's in Linfield. He enjoyed Nascar, hunting, and motorcycle racing.

In addition to his mother, Mr. Kurtas is survived by three sisters; Kathleen F., wife of Gary E. Bauer, of Pottstown, PA, Johanna M., wife of Stephen G.
