Minnie L. Thacker, 84, of Phoenixville, passed away on Friday, March 27, 2015, in the Seasons Hospice. Born in Counsel Bluff, Iowa, she moved to Phoenixville at the age of six, with her parents, the late Hubert L. and Laura (White) Thacker.

Minnie had been employed in the records department at Phoenixville Hospital. She was a member of the Phoenixville Senior Center and formerly the Phoenixville Hospital Auxiliary. From 1950-1952, she volunteered with the Red Cross at the Valley Forge Army Hospital assisting wounded soldiers disfigured during the Korean War. She was an avid painter and sold Avon locally for over 50 years.

Minnie is survived by several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by five brothers.
