Morrison C. Huston, age 88, wife of Christine M. (Hearn) Huston, of Chester Springs, PA, died peacefully at home on Thursday evening, February 14th, 2008. Born in Philadelphia, he was a son of the late Aubrey and Helen L. (Coates) Huston. He attended the Episcopal Academy, St. George's School and Princeton. Following naval service in WWII, Mr. Huston worked as Textile Marketing Director for DuPont Nemours, retiring in 1982. He served on Boards of The Church Council for the Exceptional Person, Caron International, United Way of Chester County, Camphill Village Kimberton Hills, Green Valleys Assn., French & Pickering Creeks Conservation Trust and was a long-time member and past president of The Countrymen's Club.
